DEVELOPMENT SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS

Water Tower Commons Project Update

The Residential Phase II is currently in progress. The Town has issued Site Plan approvals for both a Wawa and an Aldi, with a Chick-fil-a Site Plan currently under review. The Developer is currently working on the required Art in Public Places piece for Town approval and has indicated Town Staff should expect a rendering to be submitted before the end of the year for review and comments.

Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council Update

On August 23, 2021 Dana Little, Urban Design Director made a presentation to the Town Council to consider preparing a Master Plan for the Town. Staff has set up a follow-up meeting with Mr. Little for October 28th.

FINANCE DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") Funding Update

The Town received more than \$3.1M as the first tranche of ARPA funds in late September. Staff will evaluate the next course of action and how to best utilize these funds which must be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026. Eligible uses of funds include responses to public health concerns raised by the pandemic, responses to negative economic impacts of the pandemic, premium pay to essential workers, improvements to water and sewer infrastructure, and replacement of lost revenue due to the pandemic.

FY 2021/22 Annual Budget

Was adopted on 1st and 2nd Reading on September 13th and September 23, 2021, respectively.

LIBRARY HIGHLIGHTS

Library Remodel Project Update

While our Library facility is undergoing its remodel, the library has been temporarily relocated to 418 S Dixie Hwy, Lantana FL 33462. Our contractor – Sierra Construction is about 25% complete and has an expected completion date of January 2022. To date, the plumbing has been installed, the concrete for the new meeting room has been poured and framing is complete. The doors and windows have been ordered.

Library Programs:

- Friday Nights at the Library: The Library is open until 8:30 PM on nights the Twilight Market is held. Teens and Tweens are welcome for Virtual Reality games, video games, board games, computers, and hang out time in a safe place. Kids and teens are welcome to use the library's games and Science activities (i.e., electrical circuit kit, coding robots) at any time the library is open.
- 2. 3D printer classes coming in December.
- 3. STEM Backpacks: Thanks to FY20 LSTA grant, the library has STEM and early literacy backpacks available for check-out with library card. In each backpack is a science kit, a fun activity (i.e., gravity or laser maze, binoculars, magnet learning kit, etc.), a book on the subject, instructions and additional activities that can be done. The early literacy backpacks are similar, but with a much younger intended audience, and have activities that target the six (6) early literacy skills.

POLICE DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Current Police Department Projects:

- Currently implementing Body Worn Cameras ("BWC") to various shifts to get them familiar with the equipment as well as to troubleshoot any issues we may come across.
- On October 11th, the Town Council authorized the purchase and installation of communications center equipment from Motorola to enhance the safety and the security of our communications system. Installation is expected to begin within the next month and be completed within three (3) days.
- On November 8th the Town Council will be asked to consider the purchase of two (2) police vehicles which were approved in the FY 2021/22 Budget.
